IV. Docket of Claims Approval, Exhibit "B"

V. Authorize and approve South Liberty Baptist Church to have the 3<sup>rd</sup> Annual 5K Run & Walk on Saturday, April 26, 2025 at 8:00 with the assistance from the Police Department for safety; subject to ratification of a Usage Agreement. The walk will start at 165 E. Dinkins and go to Hwy 43.

VI. Authorize and approve reimbursement of \$600 to Briana King for rental of Multipurpose Complex (see details in information folder).

VII. Authorize payment of \$4,975.00 to System Scale for (2) traffic lights, (2) traffic poles, and (1) electrical drawing. Traffic lights and poles will be placed at scales at the Landfill and not to be used on any City of Canton streets (see details in information folder).

VIII. Authorize payment of \$61,000.00 to ADCAMP to edge mill and overlay Peco Intersection, south curb view of Loves gas station, and curb view of Loves gas station to South of Peco (see details in information folder).

IX. Authorize and approve payment of \$13,500.00 to ADCAMP to install two (2) speed bumps on Martin Luther King and remove/replace 6 speed bumps on Singleton Street (see details in information folder).
